TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF VISA ISSUANCE UNTIL 15 JANUARY 2021

The Philippine Consulate General (PCG) in Calgary wishes to inform the public of the implementation of the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) Resolution No. 91 dated 29 December 2020, which temporarily suspends flights from, and prohibits entry to the Philippines on all travelers coming from or transiting through the United Kingdom from 30 December 2020 to 15 January 2021 to address the risks posed by the new variant of the SARS-CoV-2.

Under the same IATF-EID Resolution, **all foreign travelers** coming from, or transiting through 19 other Restricted Countries/Jurisdictions, **which includes Canada**, shall also be restricted from entering the Philippines from 30 December 2020 to 15 January 2021.

In view of this development, the PCG is also temporarily suspending the issuance of visa effective immediately until 15 January 2021.

Filipino citizens coming from Canada and the other Restricted Countries/Jurisdictions, including the UK, or who have been to the same within 14 days immediately preceding arrival to the Philippines, shall not be subject to above entry restriction, but shall be required to undergo a mandatory facility-based 14-day quarantine period regardless of a negative RT-PCR result.
