In view of the developments relating to the increase of COVID-19 cases in Alberta, the Philippine Consulate General in Calgary (PCG) in Calgary strongly recommends to ***Filipino nationals who have been notified by email by the PCG about the availability of their new passports but have not yet claimed their passports*** to opt to have their new passports mailed back to them. This will help minimize the number of people coming to the PCG.

Concerned clients are encouraged to:

- **Mail letters (legibly handwritten or printed) to the PCG asking for their passports to be mailed to them. They should enclose self-addressed, self-stamped return envelopes (preferably with tracking features) that the PCG will use to mail their new passports.**
- **Please indicate in the letter the name of the passport holder, complete return address and phone number. A family may use one self-addressed, self-stamped return envelope if all passports will fit in the envelope. The letter should indicate the names of all family members claiming new passports.**
