2. Old Philippine passport or other documents evidencing Philippine citizenship, with photocopy of data page;
3. Copy of travel itinerary or airline tickets;
4. Copy of proof of immigration status in Canada (e.g. PR card, work permit, visa, etc.);
5. Copy of deportation/removal order (if applicable);
6. Supporting documents (e.g. death certificate, medical certificate, letter of request, etc.);
7. Payment of C\$ 40.50 fee, in cash or bank draft payable to **Philippine Consulate General Calgary**.

Note: 1) A Travel Document may only be applied for in emergency situations or urgent cases and should not be used for convenience in order to avoid undergoing the standard passport renewal process; 2) A Travel Document has limited validity and may only be used for direct travel to the Philippines within thirty days from the date of issue.
